

Hand-made mask (paper towel)

You will need:

- Paper towel (1 sheet)
- Stapler & staples
- Rubberbands (2)

✂ You can also use hairbands instead of rubberbands.

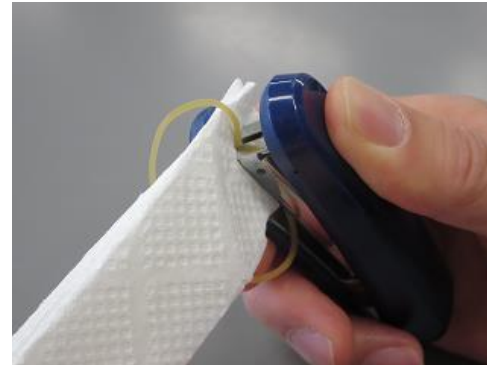


Step 1



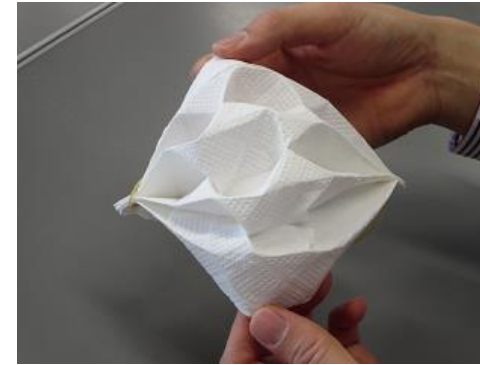
- Take a normal-sized paper towel sheet.
- Fold the sheet in 1.5cm segments using an accordion fold.

Step 2



- Place a rubberband on both ends of the folded papertowel and staple them in place.

Step 3



- Unfold the paper towel, and your hand-made mask is complete!

Step 4



- When making masks for children, adjust the size of the paper towel and placement of the rubberbands as needed.

Hand-made mask (Handkerchief)



You will need:

- Handkerchief (1)
- Rubberbands (2)

✂ Handkerchiefs can be substituted with sheets of cloth or gauze, and hairbands can be used instead of rubberbands.

Step 1



- Spread out the handkerchief, then fold it into thirds.

Step 2



- Fold the handkerchief at one end, and create a loop using a rubberband.

Step 3



- Do the same for the other end, and your mask is complete!

Step 4



- When making masks for children, adjust the size of the folds and handkerchief as needed.
