

Dial 119 for emergencies

- 1 For fires and emergencies in Japan dial 119
- 2 Even if you don't speak Japanese, dial 119
- Tell the operator you don't speak Japanese

- 4 Stay on the line to be connected to an interpreter




5 You will have a 3-way call with the operator and interpreter


What's a household smoke detector?

A household smoke detector is an emergency device that automatically detects smoke (or heat) from household fires. It assists in the quick evacuation of family members by generating an acoustic warning signal or spoken voice alert in the event of a fire.



Do you have household smoke detectors installed in your home?

☆ Household smoke detectors should be installed in bedrooms, kitchens, and stairways.



How do I check on the status of my devices?


- ☆ Periodically check if your household smoke detectors work properly.
 - The status of each household smoke detector can be checked by pushing the button or pulling the string attached to the device.




- O If there are no problems, the device will emit a sound.
- O If the device doesn't emit sound or broadcast a spoken voice alert, it may be damaged or broken.
- ☆ It is recommended to replace each device approximately once every ten years.
 - O The lifespan of a household smoke detector is about ten years long. Check when each device was installed.
 - O Depending on usage and other circumstances, it may be necessary to change the battery earlier than normal.

Make sure to have a fire extinguisher available in the event of an emergency!
